

1. A specific amount (Pecuniary legacy).

The following words will help:

I leave LWPT (The Leaders of Worship and Preachers Trust), Unit 14, Orbital 25 Business Park, Dwight Road, Watford WD18 9DA, Charity Registration Number 1107967, the sum of \underline{f} (amount in figures and words) for its general charitable purposes and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer or other duly authorised officers shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors.

2. A portion (Residuary legacy).

The following words will help:

I leave LWPT (The Leaders of Worship and Preachers Trust), Unit 14, Orbital 25 Business Park, Dwight Road, Watford WD18 9DA, Charity Registration Number 1107967, (% portion of residue to be completed) for its general charitable purposes and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer or other duly authorised officers shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors.

You may also wish to add the following two caveats to your Will to cover any future possibilities:

- i) If a charity benefitting under this Will has changed its name by the date of my death, the legacy to it in this Will will take effect as a gift to the charity in its new name.
- ii) If a charity benefitting under this Will has merged with another charity at my death, the gift to it in this Will will take effect as a gift to the charity resulting from the merger.

If you would like to inform LWPT about your decision to add a gift in your will, please let us know by giving us an insight into your reason for doing so.
